
Mediterranean Oak Borer







Learn about the biology, ecology, and best management practices of the recently detected exotic ambrosia beetle, Mediterranean oak borer (MOB; *Xyleborus monographus*), found in dead and declining valley oaks, blue oaks, and Oregon white oaks in Napa, Sonoma, Lake, and Sacramento Counties.
