

Napa County Residents: Protect Your Home from Wildfires!

The California Department of Housing and Community Development is providing up to **\$50,000 in grant funding** through ReCoverCA Housing Programs to low- and moderate-income (LMI) homeowners to reduce risk of wildfire damage and improve resiliency in the event of future disasters.

Additionally, LMI homeowners who were affected by the FEMA-declared 2020 disaster known as the Glass Fire/Lightning Complex Fire may be eligible for up to **\$500,000 in grant funding** to repair and reconstruct their homes.
